**ESSEX COUNTY FREEHOLDERS HONOR  
DR. WILLIAM MIRON - NEW JERSEY CHAPTER  
NATIONAL WRESTLING HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE**

(Newark, NJ) – On Wednesday, November 1, 2017, the Essex County Board of Chosen Freeholders honored Millburn High School Principal Dr. William Miron, New Jersey Chapter National Wrestling Hall of Fame Inductee.

Freeholder At-Large Patricia Sebold sponsored and presented Dr. Miron with the Board's Commendation for being selected as an inductee for his dynamic career in the field of Wrestling.

In 1974, Dr. Miron graduated from Millburn High School as a State Champion and member of the school's two-time undefeated wrestling team. In 1978, he graduated from Princeton University as a member of its three-time All-Ivy undefeated team, a team that also became Eastern Champions.

After graduating from Princeton, he began his career as a Mathematics Teacher at Seton Hall Prep and later taught at Millburn High School until 2000. From 1978 to 2000, he

served as a Clinician and Coach for state all-star wrestling teams. Additionally, he served as Millburn's Head Wrestling Coach from 1981 to 2001, leading the team to win five Conference Titles and two District Championships.

He has held positions as the Region Ranking Chairman for Wrestling and Treasurer of various wrestling organizations, such as the New Jersey Wrestling Federation and the New Jersey Hall of Fame.

In 2000, Dr. Miron went on to become the Supervisor of Mathematics for Kindergarten through 12th grade for Millburn Schools and the Director of the District Wrestling Tournaments. Soon after, he became the Chairman of the Lake Award for Contributions to Wrestling, Vice Principal of Millburn High School, and later Principal.

His outstanding career in both wrestling and education were characterized by noteworthy accomplishments that Freeholder At-Large Patricia Sebold so proudly recognized during the presentation.
