What is the Boarding Home Services Program?

The Boarding Home Services Program provides services to residents of boarding homes in Essex County which are intended to ensure their health and safety in the community. Some of the services provided include outreach, information and referral, case management and protective services to prevent possible abuse, neglect or exploitation.

**HOW MUCH INCOME
AND
RESOURCES CAN I HAVE

STILL BE ELIGIBLE?**

There are no income and resource maximums for this program. All or any persons residing in boarding homes in Essex County are eligible to receive services under this program.

**WHAT DO I NEED TO APPLY
FOR
BOARDING HOME SERVICES PROGRAM?**

Since all/any persons residing in boarding homes in Essex County are eligible to receive services under this program, there are no specific documents required when applying.

WHAT ARE MY RESPONSIBILITIES?

- To help the welfare agency obtain information about your situation and to determine your eligibility for services.
- To notify the welfare agency when you or any family member moves, gets a job or experiences any change in income, resources or circumstances.
